

2008-09 Webmaster Report – BCS Belfast Branch

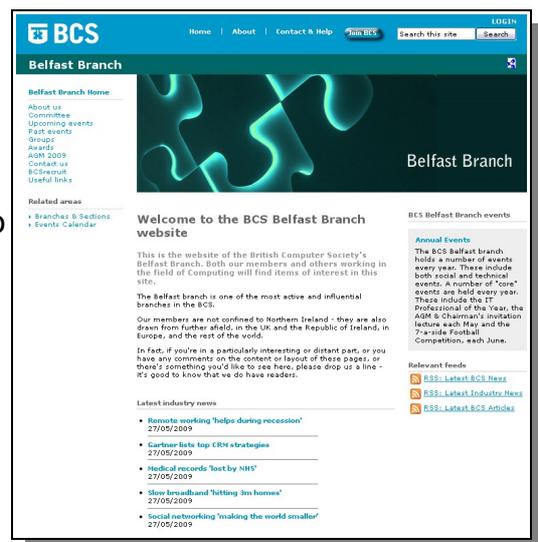
This year has seen the launch of a new branch website on the **bcsbelfast.org** domain. This was driven largely by the high charges of our previous supplier, and the availability of BCS-provided hosting. Taking control of our domain registration, and moving to free-of-charge web hosting will save the branch and the society several hundred pounds per annum – not to be sneezed at in the current economic climate.

For now the website is a fairly static affair, but we are considering ways in which to increase our interaction with the branch membership. Suggestions under consideration are:

- ◆ blogging,
- ◆ recordings (possibly in the form of a podcast) of our technical events,
- ◆ online payments for certain events
- ◆ social networking features (the YPG facebook group is an example of this approach), and technologies like twitter.
