3. Chair's Report

No further information or feedback on the Budget so not yet clear if accepted.

GDPR confirmation received from all confirming information not kept.

BCS Base camp – would like to move to BCS Base Camp as a way of sharing documents / online discussions, and it makes sense. Proposal to the group to move for documents from a particular date in future (TBD) for new discussions and potentially other items such as scheduling if useful (we don't need to move everything at once, start what most beneficial features).

Haiyan also to get on to the BCS ELITE mailing list. It was suggested Phil ask for all those on the Committee Mailing list to confirm they are getting emails.

Consider also setting up an re "Tomorrows Leadership" promoting ELITE and what it does - as a recruitment event - think about this, no action.

The LinkedIn Group situation was discussed. Currently awaiting response from BCS legal. Noted from Chris Tiernan that iw as originally set up to be independent of BCS.

It was considered if the following excerpt from BCS Code of Conduct may be applicable in governing how the LinkedIn ELITE group is run.

Duty to the Profession - You will not make any statement on behalf of BCS or purport to represent BCS through any public medium, including digital social media, unless authorised to do so by BCS. https://www.bcs.org/upload/pdf/conduct.pdf

5. EuroCIO

Five National Bodies are understood to have not renewed, and EuroCIO may be adjusting their position about memberships. It is recommended therefore that BCS ELITE pause to await the outcome of EuroCIO next deliberations and therefore communicate to EuroCIO group that we have decided not to move ahead, to ensure value and best possible use of BCS (ELITE) funds.

6. Treasurer's Report (Owen)

Jacqui called for any outstanding expenses to be submitted ASAP and well before end of August – notably John McCarthy EuroCIO Hanover expenses.

Jacqui: Taking in to account 2 large invoices (N.England) plus £1,000 for white paper we have around £600 left in the budget to cover John's expense and the event tonight, so we would be on hold with further expenditure (unless an SFR to be raised).

As August 28th is the next meeting and is an event brainstorm without refreshments, materially cost neutral. September 26th (which does include refreshments) will need to be in the new budget ie as is appropriate to fall int eh period when costs fall due.

7. White Paper

Mark John Hall and Martin shared their proposal, updated the group via Martin.

It was debated whether to be exclusively about Female leadership in IT or whether wider (noting that IT leaders to be interviewed could all be female).

We could ask BCS HQ if it can be linked to other activities, eg trial new model for future white papers as part of a wider campaign, not a spot tactical event. Is there a non-BCS outlet that can also help to promote, eg via CIO UK (that also includes CIO 100 ie quite well known and influential people).

A D&I series may be with consideration, perhaps along the lines of events reflective of 'someone like me' (eg autism, accessibility, disability, ethnicity, other tbd). Potential brainstorm to be held in August in the events discussion.

Note: Deadline for completion and invoicing based on current budgeted costs before end August.

It was considered that video may be high cost – but we could perhaps consider a 'talking heads' approach or bite-sized chunks could also be useful.
