





# 2020-2021 – Budget Allocation

- **Sep 2019 to Aug 2020**

- Budget: £1,800
- Expenditure: £218  
(Pop-up banner and speaker expenses, expenditure reduced due to Covid-19)

- **Sep 2020 to Aug 2021**

- Budget: £1,456.61
- No proposed expenditure at this point due to uncertainty re Covid-19

- **Notes:**

- Allocation is standard, in line with all SG's
- Travel & accommodation costs must be minimised
- All events will need to have SFR's
- Where possible for events we need to look for sponsorship etc
- Planned events/SFRs for 2020/21 are;

# Governance of BCS Member Groups

All BCS members groups, i.e., Branches, International Sections and Specialist Group are governed by BCS Rules for Member Groups.

- **We have fully complied with the Member Group Rules**
  - Rules for BCS Member Groups are developed by BCS Membership Board Policy Committee and are documented here: [www.volunteer.bcs.org/rules](http://www.volunteer.bcs.org/rules)
  - A two stage consultation is conducted with BCS members every time there is a proposed change to the Rules for Member Groups.
  - There is a hierarchy of governance documents relating to BCS Member Groups (highest to lowest): Royal Charter, Byelaws, Code of Conduct and Rules for Member Groups.
  - The rules are designed to be the minimum required, as simple as possible and are open to consultation among all members before ratification by Membership Board.

# Committee Meetings, Agendas and Minutes


- The BCS L&D SG Committee met 9 times online since the last AGM.


