Two candidates answered this question, both failing to gain marks by omitting considerable parts of their answers, thus failing to achieve the requisite marks. One marginally failed and the other just passed.

All three candidates answered this question with one extremely good answer and two very moderate answers. These candidates failed to answer significant parts of the question which the good candidate answered with ease.

Two candidates answered this question. One answer was of an extremely high standard and the other was a marginal pass. This was because the candidate failed to complete each stage of their answer in sufficient detail.
