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Visual Impairment: Spectrum of conditions which impact on the ability to see. 4% of those registered blind see nothing at all.

Understanding Sight-loss

Temporary Sight loss Issues

- Usually over a short period of time.
- Can be resolved by minimalist intervention.
- Ensuring materials are available which can be adjusted to accommodate the temporary sight loss.

Sight Impaired

- There is some field of vision, but the sight is restricted in some way.
- Can be resolved by minimalist intervention but there are also some facilities which need to be in place.
- Sometimes patrons will have their own aides, and equipment, but the provision of stewards at events, and detailed verbal instructions.
- Making larger print available

Severely Sight Impaired

- Extremely limited field of vision
- Requires support and intervention, usually a cane or a sighted guide.
- Reading materials are very difficult to process.
- Text to speech very helpful, free resources like Otter.AI will support the patron to be able to access materials.
- Devices such as electronic readers can be helpful.
- Software can be helpful.

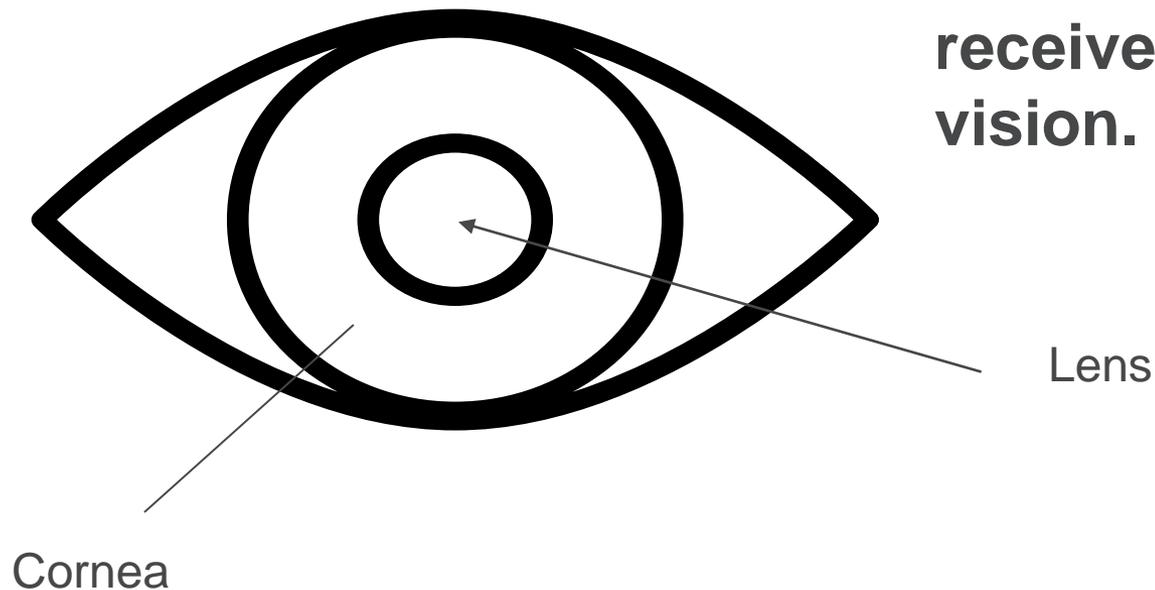
Support Framework

96% of environmental information is received through our vision.

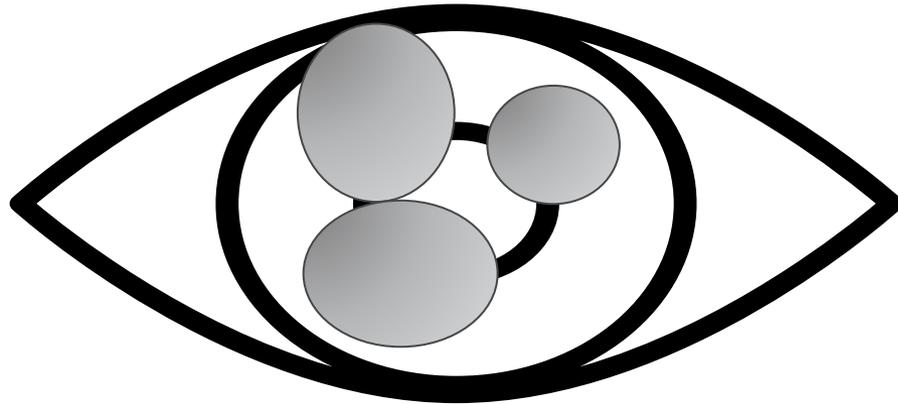


Ulcerative Keratitis

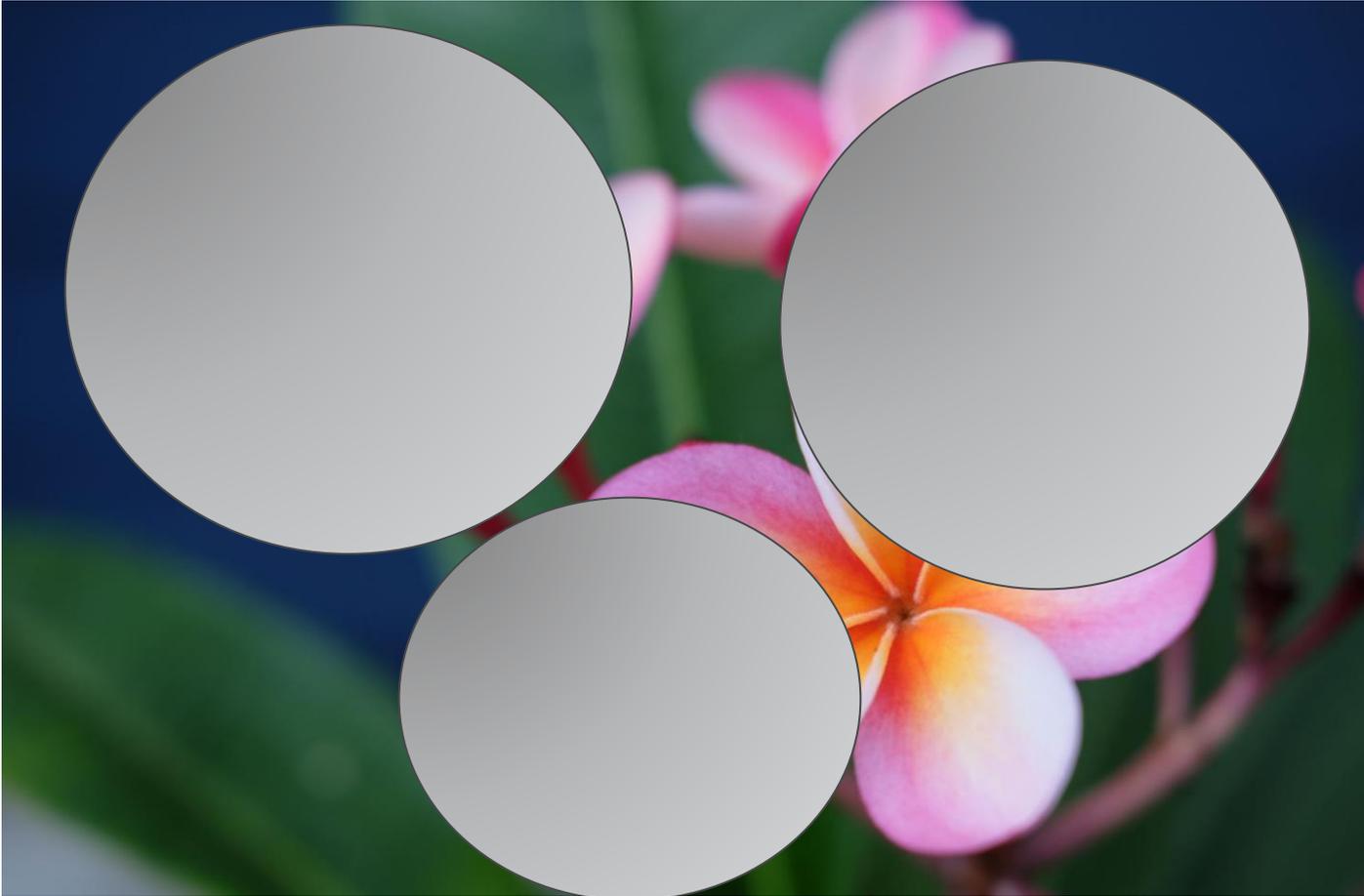

ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY

Assistive technology

Liquid
Level
Indicator



- Making a hot drink independently.
- Uses sensors and sound to minimise the risk of burning
- Three prongs, one for hot water, one for milk and one to stop the cup from overflowing

Assistive technology

- Screen displays fine detail from documents, photographs or labels
- Colour coded tactile buttons
- Contrast colour viewing modes; ability to change text and background colours

Magnification Device

Assistive technology

- Use as a magnifier
- Download VI applications
- Location services (tracking)
- QR Code Reader
- Speech recognition software



Tablet Technology

Assistive technology

- WEWalk White cane
- Location services (tracking)
- Obstacle detection
- Vibrates to inform of low-hanging obstacles

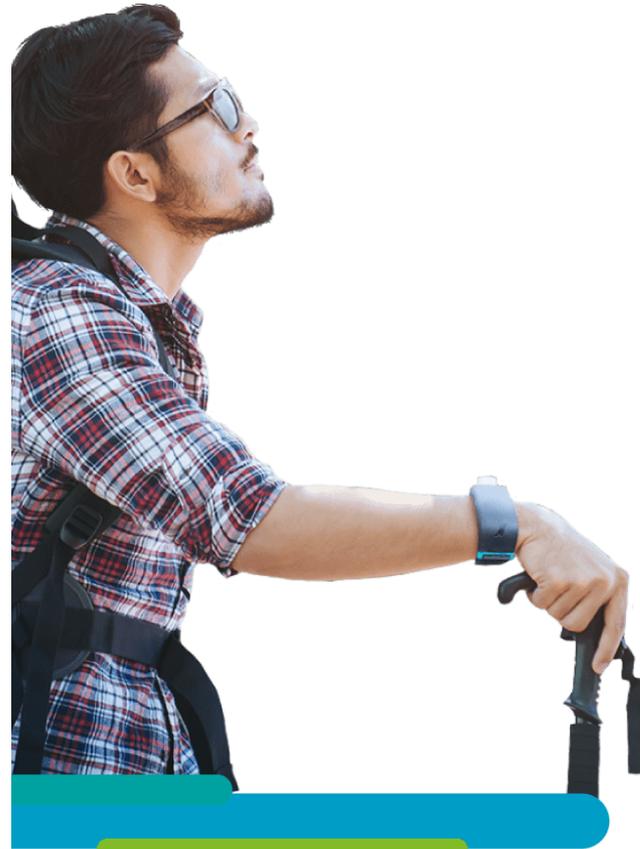

- Socially distanced (People too close)



Navigational Technology

Mobile Phone Applications: Recognition



Be My Eyes: Connects Visually Impaired and Sighted people, for support via a phone call. Used when lost in London



Seeing AI: Provides a narrative about the world around you; colours, shapes or objects.



Thirdeye: Enables users to recognize everyday objects via one button. The app replies verbally

Mobile Phone Applications: Speech to Text and Vice Versa



OtterAI: Enables Visually Impaired people to dictate into their mobile phones and this application will play back and convert speech to text.



Dragon: Provides speech to text software and voice recognition. It will also allow control of some software on a computer. It will open, close and save files.



JAWS: Job Access With Speech screen reader, for computer users whose vision loss prevents them from seeing screen content or navigating with a mouse

RNIB Bookshare: Enables Visually Impaired people and lexically challenged persons to access reading materials in a variety of accessible formats



Audible : Provides subscription access to audio books



Talking Newspapers and Magazines: Provides access to local and national newspapers and magazines

The progression of my eye condition could have been ***stopped*** before I became **blind**.

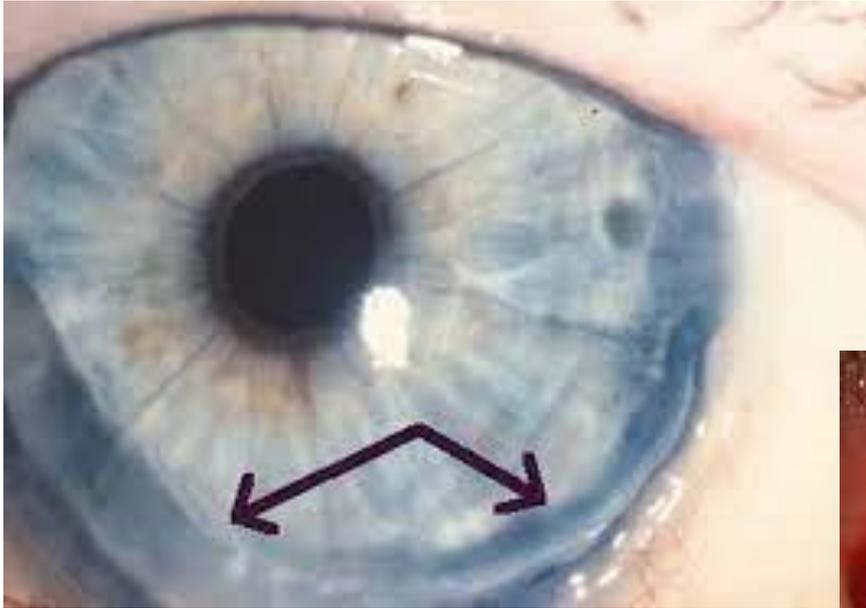
A significant proportion of blindness is preventable.

General Hygiene

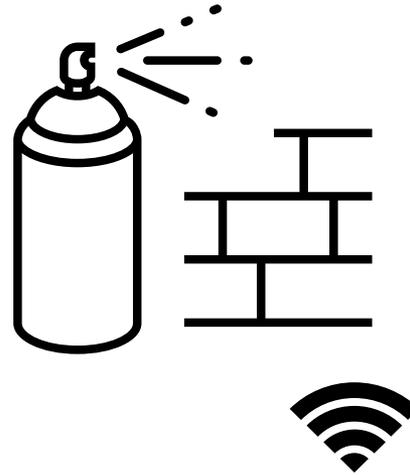
Most people in this meeting tonight will use a keyboard as part of their role.

A positive outcome from COVID should be the improvement of general hygiene.

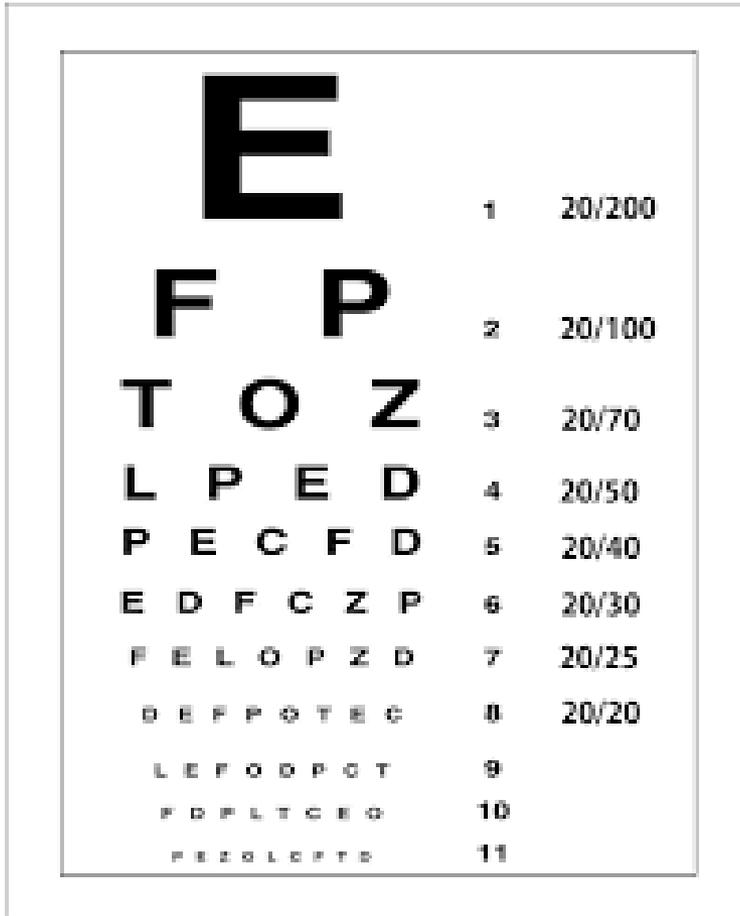


Look after your eyes!
