Report from the Treasurer

Last year we had an authorized spend of £3132. At year end we had spent £2543 or 81.2% of allocation.

This year we had authorized spend of £2105 and spent £2033 or 96.6% of allocation. The breakdown is detailed in the table below. We supported two in-person, hybrid events the 'Great Debate' & 'IOT in Berks'. We had no in-person committee meetings to make financial savings.

This year our biggest expenditure was **sponsorship** which totaled £**1035** (£1750) followed by **Travel/subsistence £359** (£382) **and Room Hire £332** (£0). The STEM sponsorship had to be separately requested and approved as 'Special Funding'.

- 1. £250 for 'SATROfest' at Cobham International School, Surrey.
- 2. £250 for 'Bucks Skill Show' in Aylesbury Bucks. (2 day event)
- 3. £250 for 'Get Inspired Basingstoke'.
- 4. £250 for 'Basingstoke Primary STEM'.

We also attended Bucks SEND (Special Education Needs) in Stoke Mandeville. We incurred travel and subsistence for these events.

Going into 2023/24 our budget, before sponsorship, has been confirmed as £1175 which is up £70 from 2022/23.
