

RSC member application guidance

This document explains how to apply to become a member of the Registration and Standards Committee (RSC), either as a new member or a request to continue onto a second term.

Application composition

To apply for membership of the Registration and Standards Committee (RSC) you need to provide:

- A current CV
- An statement explaining why you want to join the RSC or continue onto a second term and the experience, knowledge and skills you can bring to the committee.

Your CV

Your CV must include relevant posts you've undertaken over the past 5 years, employed or voluntary, and details of any professional registrations or other committee or boards you are part of or have been in the past. It should be no longer than two pages.

Your statement

Your statement should be approximately 300 words and explain:

- Why you're interested in joining/continuing as a member of the committee.
- What knowledge, skills, and perspective you can bring to the committee. For example, a military background with 5 years of experience working in education and training and recent experience in a role whereby you've influenced the governance of a department/business (e.g., policy setting).
- An example of how you have contributed to 'making IT good for society'. This could be as a committee member, through work and volunteer activities, as a professional social influencer, etc.

The process for admitting a member to the committee
